Busway Timetable Changes

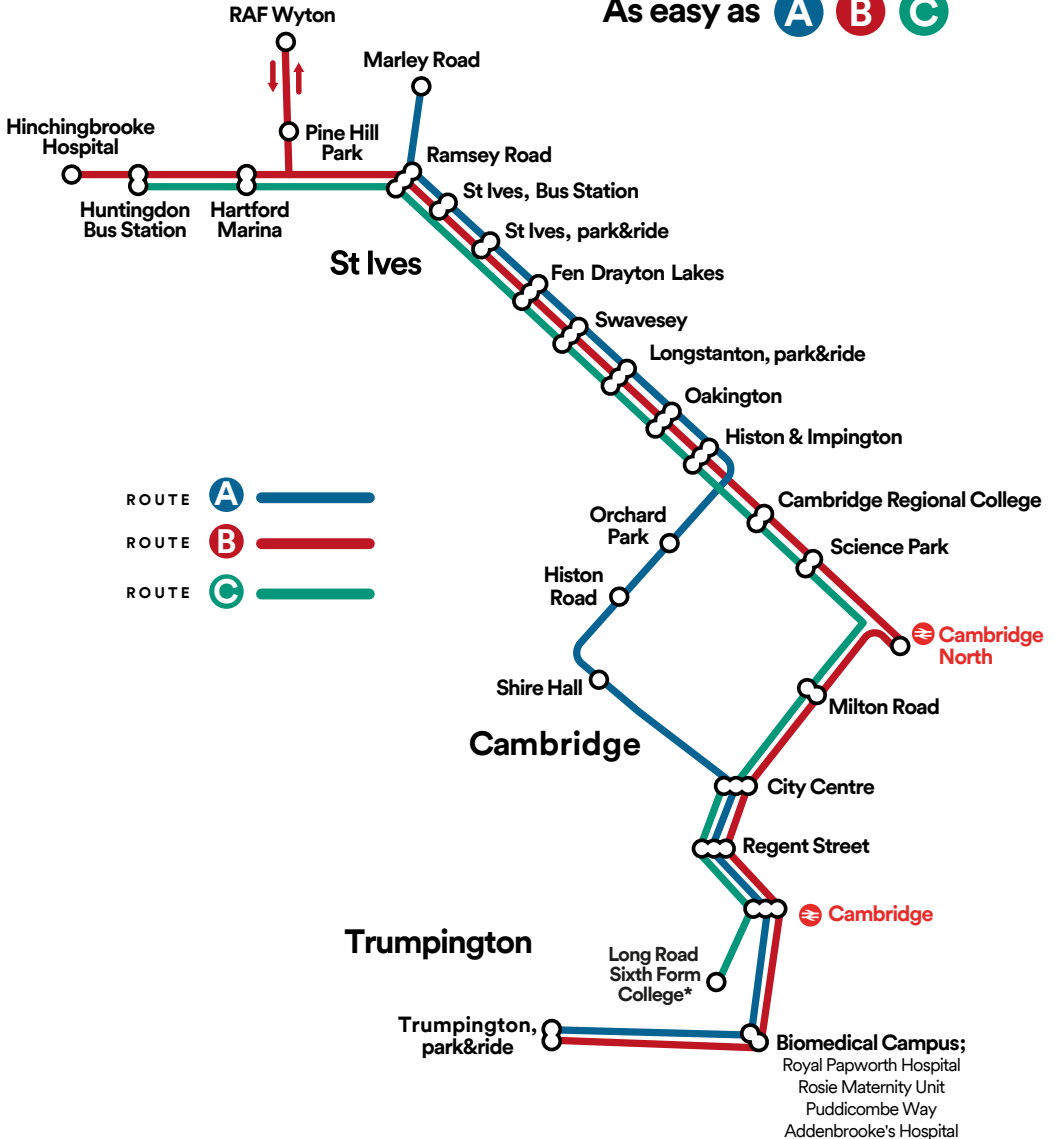
Why are we making further changes?

Commuters and school/college passengers are continuing to change how and when they travel, so from January 3rd the following changes will be made:

- More buses to and from Huntingdon at peak/college times
- Route C will be extended to and from Huntingdon to give greater capacity for route B passengers
- Routes A and B will continue through the city and Route C will remain double deck operated to provide additional capacity

An overview of the changes at morning peak times:

There will be a bus to Cambridge from St Ives, Ramsey Road every 5 minutes when routes A, B and C are combined

Routes A and B will remain unchanged:

- Single deck A and B buses will continue to run every 20 minutes along their current routes, and will serve the following stops:.

A St Ives to Trumpington:

St Ives: Marley Road, Burleigh Centre, Ramsey Road, Albemarle Road, Elm Drive, Chestnut Road, The Pound, Copperbeech Close, Langley Close, St John's Road, East Street, Station Road, Park & Ride

Cambridge: Cambridge Regional College, Science Park*, New Square, Regent Street, Railway Station (Stop 1)

Trumpington: Foster Road, Park & Ride

*The A will only serve Cambridge Regional College and Cambridge Science Park on journeys towards Trumpington. On journeys towards St Ives, the A will instead serve Shire Hall and Orchard Park.

Route C buses will now begin their journey at Huntingdon Bus Station:

- Double deck buses will run on this route every 10 minutes and will serve the following stops:

Why has Route C been extended to Huntingdon?

- **Greater capacity for Route B passengers wanting to travel beyond Cambridge City Centre.** Passengers travelling to the City Centre can board the double deck C buses from Huntingdon, freeing more space for those needing the single deck B buses which travel beyond the City Centre, to Trumpington.

- **Faster journey times for those travelling from Huntingdon to Cambridge.**

As Route C does not serve RAF Wyton and Cambridge North, this route will be approximately 8 minutes quicker reaching Cambridge from Huntingdon compared to route B.

An overview of the changes at afternoon peak times:

- Routes A, B and C will combine to provide a 5 minute frequency from Cambridge.
- More buses will start from Long Road and some Route C buses will extend to Huntingdon.
