Report for Longstanton Annual Parish Meeting Wednesday 10th May 2017

The Village Institute continues to provide a community facility for a wide range of groups. There are currently 9 regular weekly users with 4 users on a monthly basis and several other regular users who use on a less frequent basis. Bookings remain steady with morning and evenings pretty much fully booked, but afternoons are free.

The Parish Council continues to rent the office at the back of the Institute which ensures a regular income.

From September 2016 to April 2017, Longstanton Village Institute has been one of the local charities chosen by the Co-op as a recipient of their Local Community Fund. We have been fortunate to receive £2,614.00 from this and want to express our thanks to everyone who picked the Village Institute as their charity when shopping at the Co-op. The money has been earmarked for essential maintenance work.
