Report for the Annual Parish Meeting

29th April 2019

Following access gained by travellers who left their horses last year, the charity has been taking reasonable measures to secure the access and maintaining in accordance with ongoing discussions.

Longstanton Parish Council reported to residents by way of a newsletter in Summer/Autumn 2018 that trustees have been working closely with solicitors and other professionals to find the best solution to selling the charity land. The land itself is identified in the Northstowe Masterplan as part of Phase 3b and if able to sell the land, it will provide the village with significant capital towards the community build project.

Work has been ongoing with regular meetings held with professionals and trustees to keep the momentum moving forward. We hope to be able to come back to residents over the summer with more detailed news and perhaps an open meeting.

Other than the above, the charity continues not to create any income. As reported last year, Longstanton has loaned the charity money to allow it to carry out the above. These will be repaid to the parish council upon the receipt of any sales money.
