## AND THE POOR'S LAND CHARITY

This Charity consists of 2 pieces of land, both situated in Over.

- a) 3 acres (approx) of land at Bare Fen
- b) 7 acres (approx. of land at Gravel Bridge

The Trust was set up by the Charity Commissioners in 1898 but the land belonged to the Parish of Longstanton as far back as 1624. Formal Tenancy agreements were only drawn up in 1975 although the land was leased to the existing tenants before this.

The income of the Charity is supposed to be used for the benefit of deserving and necessitous persons residing in the village. In practice cash payments are given to approximately 45 persons per year at Christmas who are over 70 years old and have resided in the village for at least 20 years. It is not a hard and fast rule and in the past has relied heavily on Trustees with local knowledge.

The present Trustees are Ann Meadows (Clerk), Carol Collis, Sylvia Hicks and Pat Sheridan.
